No more cuts: SFU students need higher funding from the provincial government.

In April '08, the Provincial Government cut \$6 million of funding from SFU - *before the recession*. Now fewer scholarships and bursaries are available for students.

In July '09, students lost loan repayment assistance and even more scholarships.



SFU needs proper funding, not cutbacks.

Higher student funding should result in lower tuition fees.

Students pay a lot of money to go to university. In fact, costs have soared over the last decade: tuition fees have *more than doubled* since 2001/2002.

With twice the tuition fees to pay every year, many students struggle to afford their education.
